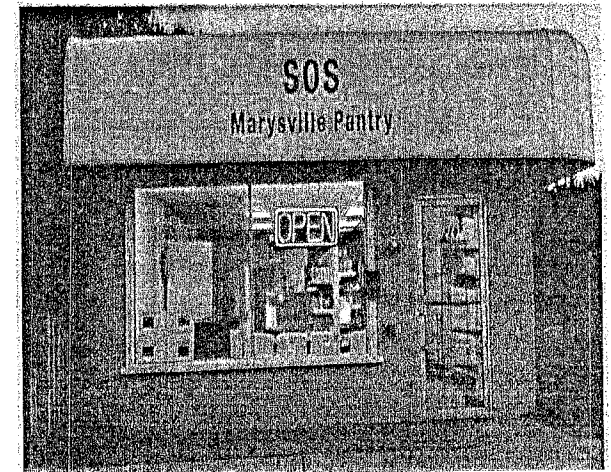
Did you know...

- Over 26% people in St. Clair County live on incomes that could put them at risk of hunger at some time each month.
- Households undergoing a crisis make up 60% of all households receiving food. Crises include loss of job or income, sudden illness, and high medical bills.
- Only 5% of emergency food recipients are homeless.
- About 50% of food pantry clients are children.
- One of the busiest times of year for a food pantry is the summer since school breakfast and lunch programs are not in place.

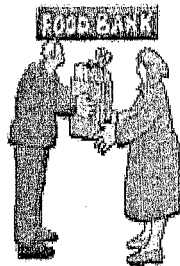


Mission Statement

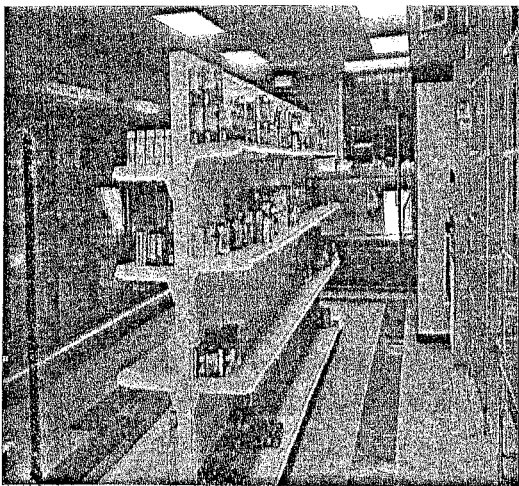
To help provide food for families and individuals in our community who are experiencing temporary financial situations in a way that preserves their dignity and provides a confidential environment.

The **SOS Marysville Food Pantry** was created in response to community need by local churches and service organizations. It opened its doors in the summer of 2011 at the former Camm's Meat Market in Marysville.



The Pantry is operated by a team of volunteers dedicated to community service. These volunteers collect food, stock shelves, interview clients, as well as shop, distribute and deliver food. Each volunteer works hard to ensure that the Pantry's clients receive needed supplies each month.
